Aims and objectives

- Identify hate issues using quarterly monitoring reports from formal records i.e. hate crime reports and hate incident reports
- Identify hate issues using information from informal records e.g. other agencies
- Request further research e.g. analysis of quarterly hate crime report
- Review individual hate cases in order to
 - identify best practise
 - use the resources of all agencies to resolve a case when difficulties are encountered
- Raise awareness of and improve confidence in the reporting procedure
- Monitor reporting procedures with a view to improvement
- Identify and tackle blockages in reporting procedures
- Use the resources of all partnerships to tackle identified issues
- Report achievements annually to partners and to the Safer and Stronger Communities Partnership
